First is the eradication of chronic extreme poverty bringing the number of extremely poor people, defined as those living on less than 1.25 purchasing power parity (PPP)†“adjusted dollars a day, to less than 3 percent of the world’s population by 2030. The second is the boosting of shared prosperity, defined as promoting the growth of per capita real income of the poorest 40 percent of the population in each country. How we answer the above questions can therefore have a major influence on the global economy.

Conditional Cash Transfers Ariel Fiszbein, Norbert R. Schady, 2009-02-09 Conditional Cash Transfer (CCT) programs aim to reduce poverty by making welfare programs conditional upon the receivers' actions. That is, the government only transfers the money to persons who meet certain criteria. They therefore need to be complemented with other interventions, such as workfare or employment programs, and social pensions.
